What happened?	A Kemek employee was driving a MEMU with no passenger on route to customer quarry when he came upon an oncoming truck, he attempted to move to his left to allow more room but the side of the road gave way and the MEMU left the road and ended up on its passenger side in a drainage ditch and field. The driver was uninjured and there was minimal spillage however the MEMU received significant damage to the passenger side of the vehicle.
